

Setting up Microsoft Exchange 2013 on Your iPhone

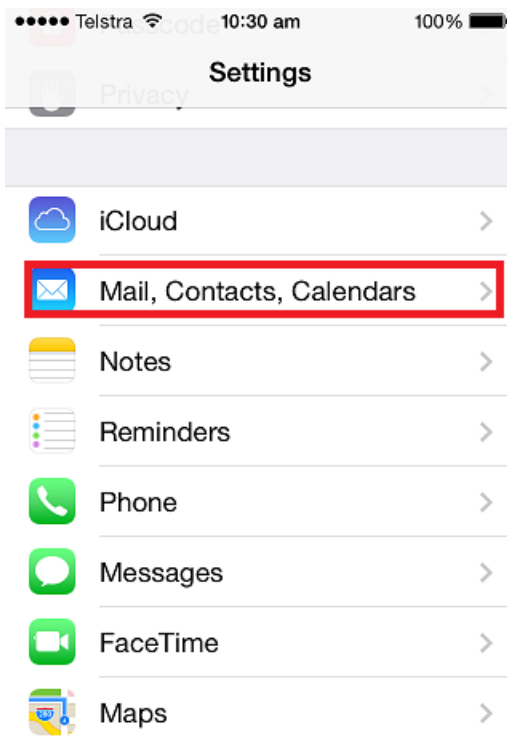
Step 1

Go to settings.



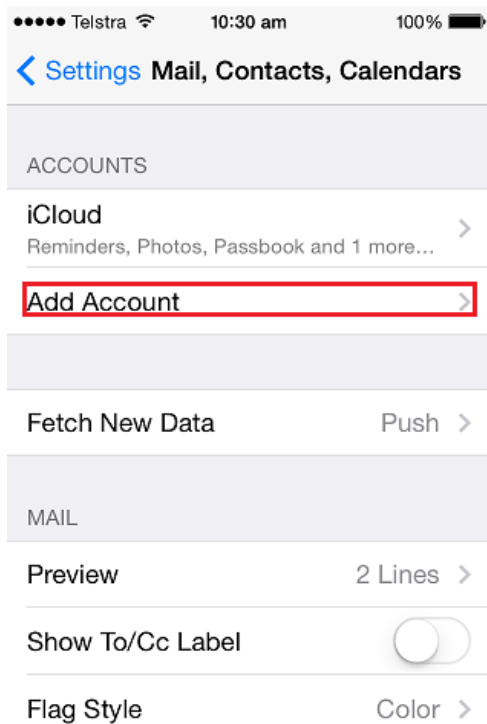
Step 2

Go to Mail, Contacts, and Calendars.



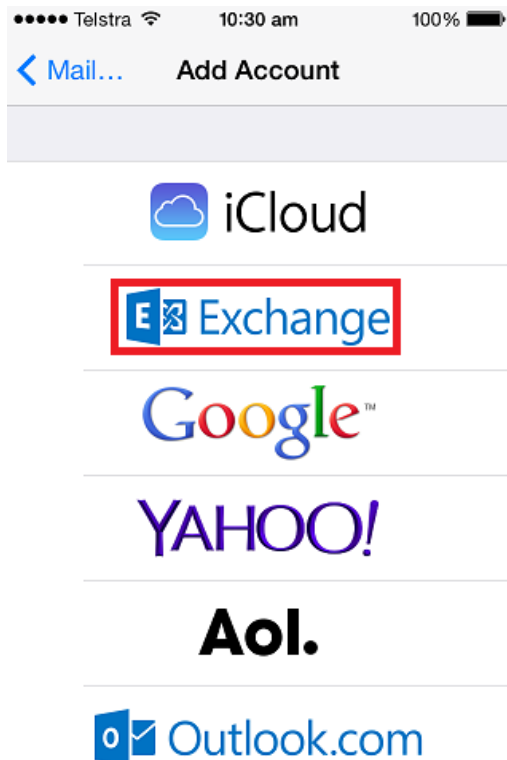
Step 3

Go to add account.




Step 4



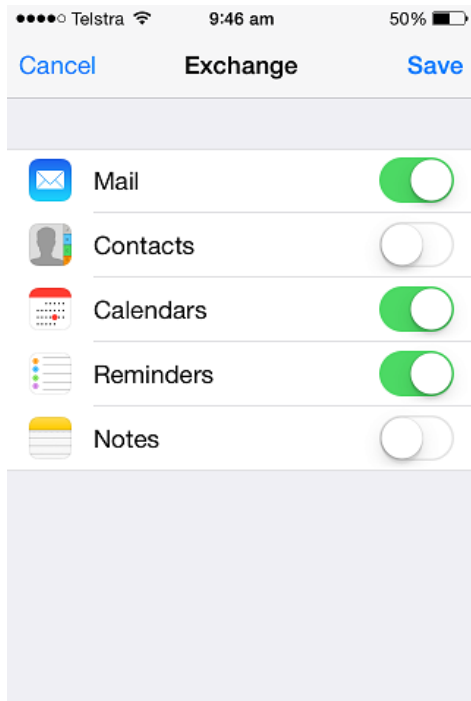
