4. Loan caps will apply to all eligible VET Student Loan (VSL) courses. The capped amount is the maximum Commonwealth loan a student will be able to apply for that particular course. If a student's course fees are higher than that amount, the student will be required to pay for the variance themselves at enrolment. Other than for specified exceptions, there will be three loan cap bands of \$5,595, \$11,191 and \$16,788, which will apply irrespective of whether the course is being delivered face-to-face, online, RPL or via mixed delivery modes.
