1. # Under the State Government's "Free in 23" initiative the tuition fees are 100 percent free for this course.
2. These fees are estimates only for students enrolling in state government funded courses on a full-time basis.

These differences generally result from adapting courses to meet local industry needs. The actual cost of a course may also vary between students if different electives are chosen.

5. Loan caps will apply to all eligible VET Student Loan (VSL) courses. The capped amount is the maximum Commonwealth loan a student will be able to apply for that particular course. If a student's course fees are higher than that amount, the student will be required to pay for the variance themselves at enrolment. Other than for specified exceptions, there will be three loan cap bands of \$5,595, \$11,191 and \$16,788, which will apply irrespective of whether the course is being delivered face-to-face, online, RPL or via mixed delivery modes.
