## **Course Note: Diploma of Youth Work**

- 1. # Under the State Government's "Lower Fees, Local Skills" initiative, students who are 15 24 years old or hold an eligible concession, the tuition fee will cap at \$400 and for non-concession students the tuition fee will cap at \$1.200.
- 2. These fees are estimates only for students enrolling in state government funded courses on a full-time basis.
- 3. The indicative fees for a course may differ between campus locations due to the units they have included in the course outline. These differences generally result from adapting courses to meet local industry needs. The actual cost of a course may also vary between students if different electives are chosen.
- 4. Concessions and annual course fee caps may also apply to some courses. Fee caps are only shown on the basis that all units are commenced in 2023.
- 5. Loan caps will apply to all eligible VET Student Loan (VSL) courses. The capped amount is the maximum Commonwealth loan a student will be able to apply for that particular course. If a student's course fees are higher than that amount, the student will be required to pay for the variance themselves at enrolment. Other than for specified exceptions, there will be three loan cap bands of \$5,595, \$11,191 and \$16,788, which will apply irrespective of whether the course is being delivered face-to-face, online, RPL or via mixed delivery modes.
