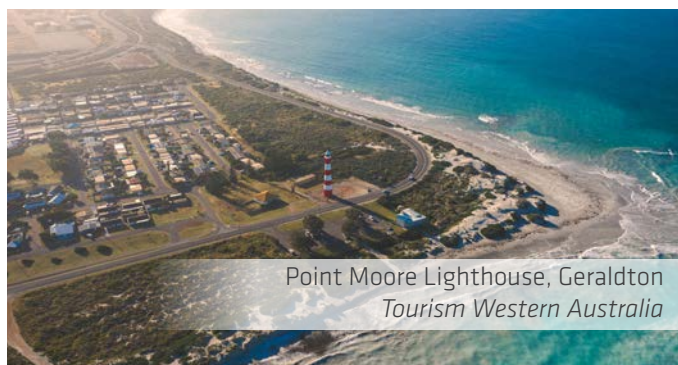
OUR REGIONS

CHOOSING A QUALIFICATION

Whether you are looking for employment, seeking a career change, leaving school or chasing a promotion - CR TAFE can open the door to your future with quality, flexible training to fit your lifestyle.



Diploma and Advanced Diploma

These higher level qualifications will give you more specialised and complex skills and knowledge, allowing you to appraise, synthesise, manage and evaluate workplace situations effectively. Graduates at this level will have the ability to undertake highly skilled work. Both qualifications can be a pathway to university and can give you credit towards a Bachelor Degree. Duration of qualifications will vary for each course.



Certificate IV

At this level you will learn supervisory and advanced technical skills which may build on skills already acquired in the workplace or obtained in a Certificate III. A Certificate IV can lead directly to higher level qualifications or be a pathway to university.



Certificate III

At this level you will gain broad theoretical and practical knowledge in your chosen industry, preparing you to take on added responsibility. Some Certificate III courses are also offered as an apprenticeship or traineeship.



Certificate I and II

These entry level qualifications will help you develop basic skills and knowledge and prepare you for both employment and further education and training.



Vocational Education and Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS)

These entry level qualifications will help you develop basic skills and knowledge, and prepare you for both employment and further education and training.



School Based Traineeship or Apprenticeship

A School Based Traineeship/Apprenticeship provides an opportunity for full-time secondary school students to begin preparing themselves for a career in the workforce. Students can work towards secondary graduation and an industry recognised qualification.



Apprenticeships and Traineeships

Apprenticeships and traineeships combine study with workplace training. You must be employed as an apprentice or a trainee before enrolling in an apprenticeship or traineeship program.



Skill Sets

These courses provide nationally accredited certification for a specific workplace skill and contain one or more units of competency. When you complete a skill set course, you receive a statement of attainment. In some cases this may give you credit towards completing a higher qualification with further study.



Short Courses

These courses help you start higher education and prepare to work with confidence. They can also help to advance existing skills or learn something completely new.

WHAT STUDY OPTION SUITS YOU?

Choose a delivery mode best suited to your needs

FACE-TO-FACE/ON CAMPUS

Often known as 'on campus' study and may be scheduled during the day or evenings. Some courses are also offered part-time.

FLEXIBLE DELIVERY

Study at your own pace, while still having access to a lecturer for all your questions and needs. This option is beneficial to those wanting to combine work and study. *Some courses may require students to be on campus for practical components or assessments.*

ONLINE LEARNING

Students will have access to virtual classrooms and an online learning portal. *Some courses may require students to be on campus for practical components or assessments.*

BLENDED DELIVERY

A mixture of online study and on campus class time.

INTENSIVE BLOCKS

Gain a qualification in a reduced time frame, with minimal class time. Course work, assignments and projects are completed in your own time.

APPRENTICESHIPS/TRAINEESHIPS

Apprenticeships

A full-time employment-based training program lasting 3-4 years. An apprenticeship combines on-the-job learning and scheduled training with a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) provider.

Traineeships

Full-time employment-based training program, often for a duration of 12 months or more.

PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS

Employment contracts are not required for this option. A great step towards securing a future apprenticeship.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

RPL is a form of assessment acknowledging formal and informal learning gained through:

- Previous training and education
- Past and current work experience
- Life experience

The RPL process involves validation of existing skills and knowledge, allowing you to obtain credits in a course and, in some cases, a full qualification.

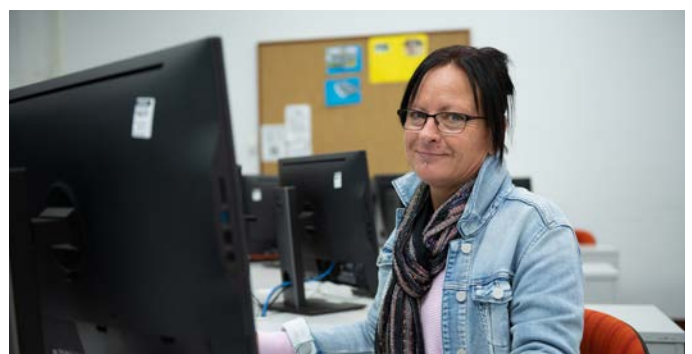
The RPL-Assessment range of evidence includes questionnaires and observations. Assessment uses a range of evidence such as academic records, proof of training course/workshop attendance, written support by previous employers and by viewing procedures and processes undertaken in your workplace.

GAIN AN ADVANTAGE

Pre-apprenticeships

A pre-apprenticeship enables you to experience what it is like to work in a trade before you make a commitment to continuing in that employment field or gaining an apprenticeship.

If you go on to an apprenticeship, the off-the-job training component of your apprenticeship training may be reduced.

Completion of a pre-apprenticeship entitles you to a Certificate II qualification. Pre-apprenticeships are full-time training courses and although you do not get paid during the course, work placement opportunities do form part of your training.

Generally there are no entry requirements or experience needed to enrol in a pre-apprenticeship course.

Benefits:

- Gain an insight and understanding of your chosen trade career.
- Basic trade skills.
- An increased chance of employment as an apprentice (*most employees are more inclined to take on new apprentices who already have industry knowledge and experience*).
- Complete trade qualification faster (*completion of a pre-apprenticeship may make you eligible to have your apprenticeship length reduced*).

EARN WHILE YOU LEARN

Apprenticeships and Traineeships

Apprenticeships and traineeships combine training with work, so that you can earn while you learn.

CR TAFE provides the formal training needed to gain your qualification in your chosen employment field.

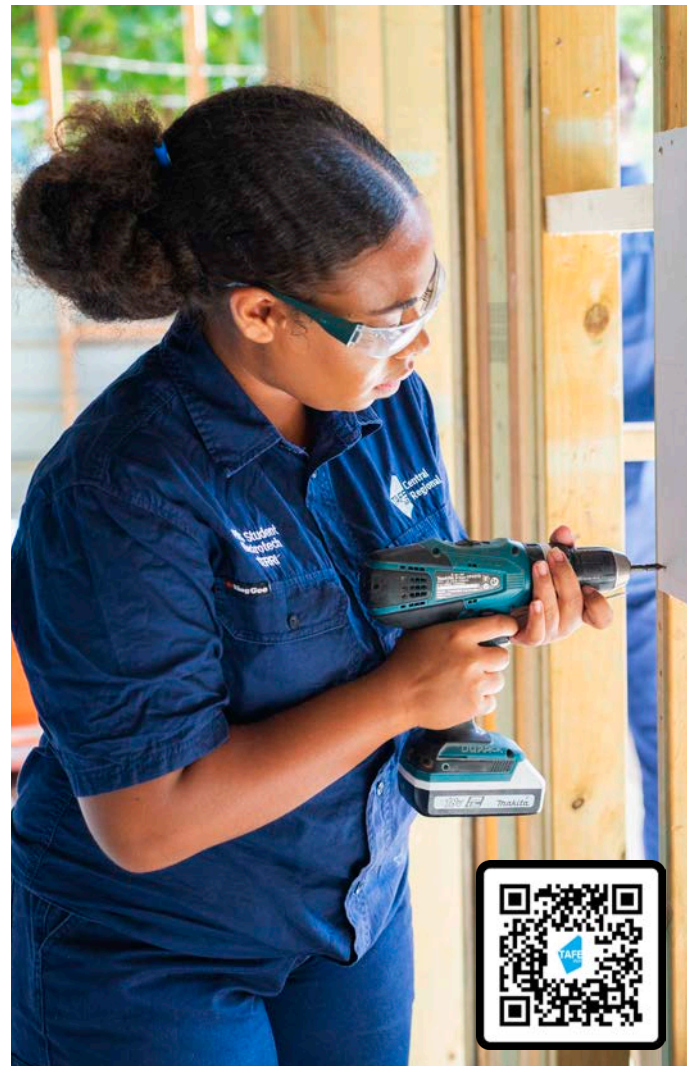
You would be required to enter into a formal training contract with an employer to learn practical skills on the job in conjunction with time spent training at TAFE. We work closely with industry, community and government to develop programs that meet workplace needs.

Are you interested in further study including university? A Diploma qualification from CR TAFE enables you to enrol into a university degree, regardless of your age or high school results.

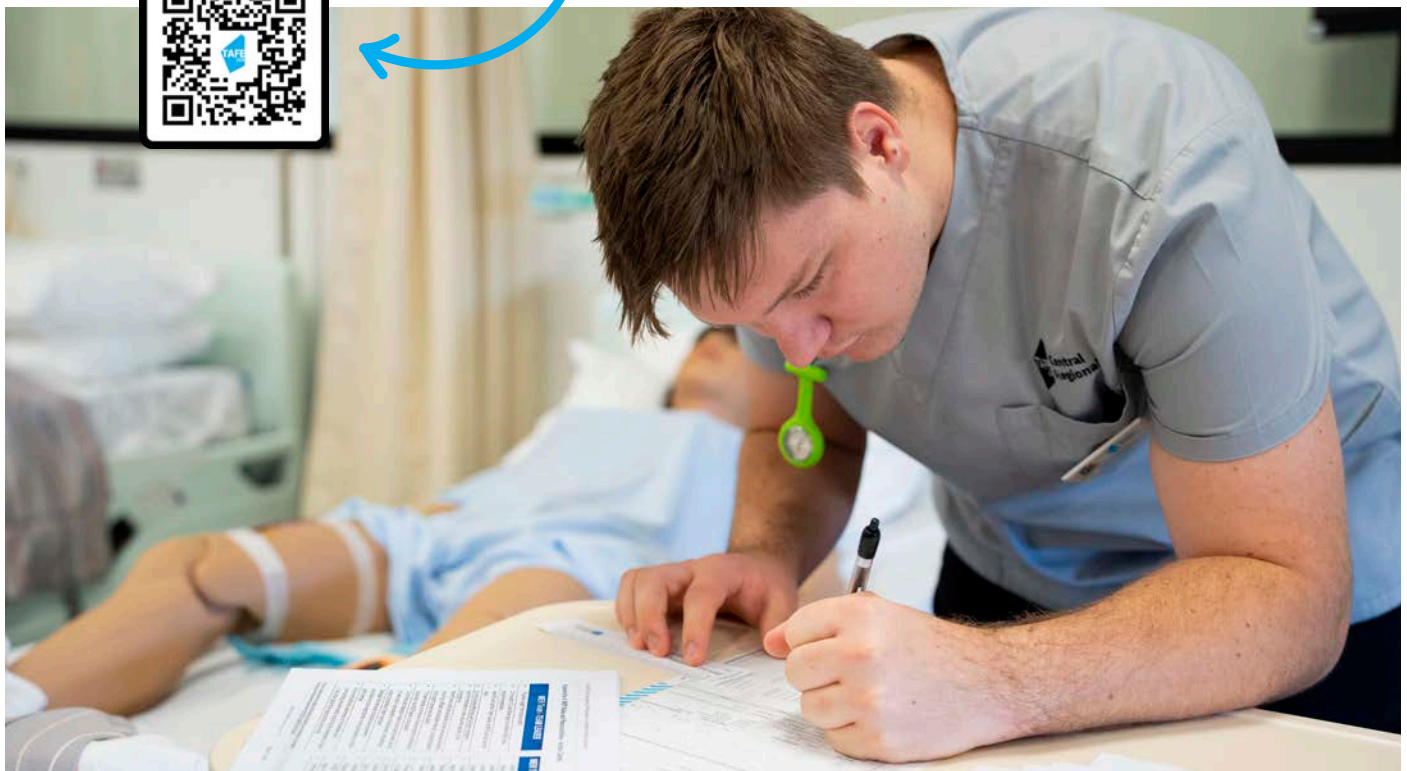

HOW TO ENROL

You have decided to take the next step and open the door to a world of new opportunities by enrolling with us at CR TAFE. The following information will help you get started!

Entrance requirements

Each course offered at CR TAFE has its own minimum entry requirements. These will either be a lower level qualification or demonstrated numeracy and literacy skill levels. More information can be found on our website, simply scan the QR code on this page.

Although many CR TAFE courses do have minimum entry requirements, there are many ways to gain entry into your chosen course; our Student Business Systems team can help you further with your options.

LANGUAGE, LITERACY AND NUMERACY SUPPORT

Adequate language, literacy and numeracy skills are required when studying. A range of options are available to anyone who feels they may need additional support in these areas.

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

The Australian Government requires all students who are enrolling or re-enrolling in nationally recognised training to register for a Unique Student Identifier (USI) reference number. A USI number will allow your account to be linked with the National Vocational Education and Training (VET) Data Collection, enabling you to see all of your training results (from 2015 onwards) from providers including all completed training units and qualifications.

Starting your application

Once you have searched our course page for an option that fits your career pathway, you are ready to kickstart your enrolment journey. There are a few things you need to know before applying:

1. We have **two** main intakes per year - Semester 1 and Semester 2. On occasion, some courses are available to start in Term 2 or 4.
2. Some courses rely on community interest prior to delivery, which will require an expression of interest.
3. Eligibility requirements are set to ensure you have a successful study journey.
4. Be prepared with all the required documents for your course so you have everything ready to apply.

TAFE ADMISSIONS

Our full-time courses require an application ahead of time due to limited availability. Applications open a couple of months prior to the start of a semester.

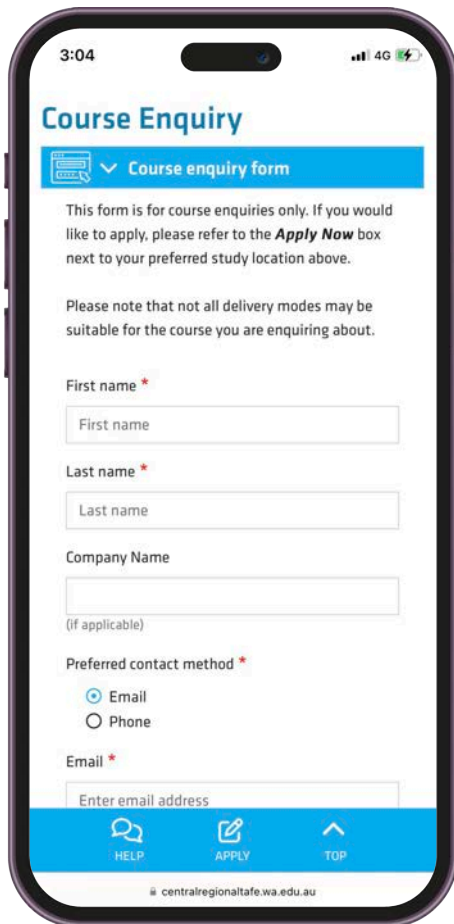
Application opening and closing dates can be found on the course page, with intakes in both semester one and two.

ROLLING ENROLMENTS

CR TAFE offers many courses with enrolments open all year round. These are self-paced onsite and self-paced external.

COURSES TAKING EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

If the course you are interested in does not have an active 'Apply Now' button to the right of the course information, scroll down and send a Course Enquiry form to seek an expression of interest.



COURSES TAKING ENROLMENTS

1. Select the location and/or mode of delivery. If the course is online, you are able to enrol into any campus with availability.
2. If you are unsure about meeting entry requirements, complete a Course Enquiry Form.
3. Check the delivery method you have selected is right for you; sometimes there is more than one listed.

4. When you are ready, click the 'Apply Now' button and you will be taken to the TAFE Admissions website. Follow the prompts and submit your application.
5. Upon receiving an offer, you will be sent a link to complete our Online Registration Form. Ensure all relevant documents are attached such as proof of WA residency/visa/concession and your USI number.
6. Once we receive your completed Online Registration Form, one of our Student Business Systems Officers will send you a fee estimate for your enrolment and our fee payment options.
7. After receiving payment, your enrolment will be confirmed and your study journey will begin!

Missing out on an offer, or realising you want to enrol but it is too late in the year, can be disappointing, however, there are options.

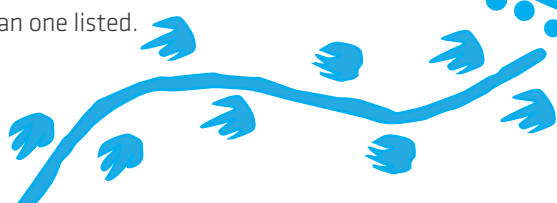

Fees and payment options

Don't let finances worry you. We offer a variety of payment solutions and can help find the best option for you. This ensures students can enjoy their training experience. There is no reason to put your future on hold, so get started today!

COURSE FEES

Fees vary for each course and are based on the number of hours within each unit of that course. Resources and materials are not included in the tuition fees and will incur an additional cost. If you have an eligible and valid concession card, the course fees are charged at a reduced rate. No fees apply for Vocational Education and Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS).

COURSE FEE REPAYMENT OPTIONS

CR TAFE endeavours to make training accessible by offering various payment options to assist students in meeting their repayment obligations, including instalment plans.

VET STUDENT LOANS

VET Student Loans is a Commonwealth Government loan scheme that helps eligible students pay their course fees for certain Diploma or Advanced Diploma qualifications.

Get Skills Ready!

There has never been a better time to kickstart your career goals. Skills Ready is a State Government initiative, providing prospective students with a range of free skills sets and half-price qualifications.

The program is expected to run until 2025, making training more accessible and affordable. Whether you are looking for a job, thinking about changing career, or up-skilling for your own development, now is the time to get skills ready.

FEE FREE TRAINING

A range of full qualifications will be **FEE FREE** (resource fees may apply) and Job Ready Skill Sets are fully **FEE FREE**. The WA Government's continued funding for the **FEE FREE** initiative will support the successful reskilling and upskilling of Western

Australians for work in a variety of priority sectors. This includes industry areas such as healthcare, community services, information and communications technology, building and construction, transport, hospitality, tourism and agriculture.

HALF-PRICE COURSES

As part of the State Government's *Lower Fees, Local Skills* (LFLS) initiative you can get a nationally recognised and accredited qualification but only pay half the fees. There are also fee caps of \$400 for 15-24 year olds or eligible concession students (\$1,200 for non-concession students). There are a large range of qualifications available with more being added, all carefully matched with the skills employers are looking for, so you will always be job ready.

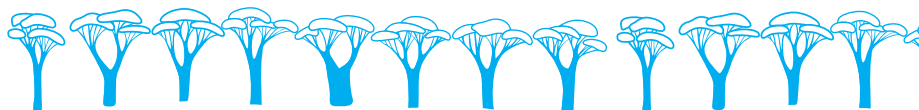
INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SUPPORT
